

Summary on the Foreign Assistance Committed during the period (January-August 2023)

- Total Foreign Aid (grants and soft loans) committed (signed grants/loans agreements) to Jordan reached US\$ (2053.8) million, including regular grants, soft loans, and Additional grants to support the Jordan Response Plan to the Syrian crisis.
 - Regular grants reached US\$ (662.2) million committed for development projects and budget support.
 - Contracted concessional loans reached US\$ (1017.7) million for development projects and budget support.
 - Additional grants to the Jordan Response Plan to the Syrian crisis (JRP) reached about US\$ (373.9) million representing (16.4%) of required JRP funding needs for 2023 estimated at US\$ (2.2) billion.
- The sectoral distribution of the Total Foreign Aid is shown as follows Budget Support (33.4%); Water and Sanitation Sector (27%); Energy sector (14.9%) Education sector (8.1%); Economic Development Sector (5.6%); Health Sector (4.6%);%), Justice, Good Governance, and Human Rights Sector (3.3%), other sectors (3.1%) (Public Sector Reform, Agriculture and Food Security sector, Employment Vocational Training and Livelihoods sector, and Environment, Institutional Capacity, Gender Sector, Youth and Sports Sector.

Cultural and Scientific Cooperation. With the aim of strengthening the cultural and scientific cooperation and relations with various countries, MOPIC has worked to conclude agreement for scientific and cultural cooperation programs in the fields of (education, higher education, culture, arts, tourism, antiquities, social development, media, communication, sports and youth) with South Korea, Greece, China and Azerbaijan, which are expected to be signed in 2023. This is in addition to the program for cooperation in the fields of education and culture with Cyprus, which was signed on 26 Abril 2023, and the cooperation program with Bulgaria in the fields of education, science and culture, which was signed in Amman on 17/7/2023.



More than (461) training programs were provided in the fields of Water, energy, trade and investment, tourism, transport, health, agriculture, media, public finance, environment and sustainable development, legislation, creativity and innovation, small and medium enterprises, cybersecurity and digital transformation, smart cities, education and vocational and technical training, publicThe Ministry has offered approximately (97) opportunities to obtain scholarships for master's and doctoral levels under the postgraduate studies programs offered by the People's Republic of China, Japan, South Korea, Thailand and the Netherlands. The opportunities were published and circulated on civil servants and universities, where 9 employees have been accepted to date.
